Each country in the State of Oklahoma may y a majority of the legal voters of such county voting upon the proposition, abolish township organization or government. The Board of County Commissioners of such county, upon a petition rigned by sistein per centum of the total number of votes cast at the last general election for the county office receiving the highest number of votes, praying that the question of abolishing township organization or government be submitted to a rote of the county, shall within thirty days after the regular meeting of such board next convening after the filing of such petition, call a special election for such purpose, or the board may in their discretion submit such question at the next general election held after the filing of such petition, If such question shall be carried, tourship. organization or government shall cease in such county, and all the duties theretofore performed by the township officers shall be cast upon and be performed by such county officers havinglike. duties to perform in relation to the county at large as such town. ship officers performed in relation to the township at large.
